ELIGIBILITY

Nominee must be

- A member of Canadian Parents for French
- Currently volunteering with CPF/CPF Staff at any level of the organization; or retired from volunteering within the last 12 months

NOMINATORS

Nominators may be any CPF member with direct knowledge of the nominee's contribution. Each nominator may nominate only one person.

RE-NOMINATION

Unsuccessful nominees may have their name resubmitted in a subsequent year. Complete and updated nomination packages must be submitted.

HOW RECIPIENTS ARE CHOSEN

Members of the review committee will include a CPF Branch volunteer, a CPF Branch staff member, a CPF National volunteer and a CPF National staff member.
